Psalm 127:1a ESV Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain...

Luke 6:46 NASB95 [Jesus said], “Why do you call Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?” 47 “Everyone who comes to Me, and hears My words, and acts upon them, I will show you whom he is like: 48 he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid a foundation upon the Rock; and when a flood rose, the torrent burst against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built. 49 But the one who has heard, and has not acted accordingly is like a man who built a house upon the ground without any foundation; and the torrent burst against it and immediately it collapsed, and the ruin of that house was great.”

Matthew 7:24 ESV “Everyone then who hears these words of Mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock.”

Matthew 7:26 ESV “And everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not do them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand.”

John 5:24 NASB95 “Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears My word and believes Him who sent Me has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death and into life.”

Ephesians 5:15 NIV Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, ¹⁶ making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord’s will is.

James 1:22 NASB Prove yourselves doers of the word, and not just hearers who deceive themselves.

1 Corinthians 3:10b NET And each one must be careful how he builds.

Proverbs 4:23 NASB95 Watch over your heart with all diligence, for from it flow the springs of life.

Romans 8:5 ESV For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. 6 For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.

Galatians 6:7 ESV Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. ⁸ For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

Jude 1:24 ESV Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, ²⁵ to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
